

Regarding COVID-19

After careful consideration, our office has made the decision to follow the recommendation of the American Dental Association and postpone all routine dental checkups, cleanings, and any non-emergent dental visits effective immediately through April 6th 2020.

At this time we are asking all patients with upcoming appointments to call our office so we can assist you in rescheduling or a member of our staff will be reaching out to you shortly.

During this time a member of our staff will be available to take your calls during regular business hours. If you have any emergent dental needs please contact us and we will make arrangements for you to be seen on March 26th or April 2nd.

Moving forward we will be exercising all necessary precautions including:

- Diligently cleaning and wiping down all surfaces, pens, clipboards, door knobs etc.
- We have removed all loose objects including magazines from the reception area to avoid contamination.
- We will begin taking the temperature of all patients prior to seeing the provider.
- Any staff member showing symptoms of being sick or has been around someone experiencing symptoms is being asked to stay home.

Please, if you are coming into the office for any reason we ask that you do not bring any extra people with you. If you have a ride we are asking that they remain in the car for you to come out. This will limit the amount of people in the office.
